EVENT DETAILS:

KATA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- All divisions will use the Flag System.- Single Elimination (Two at a time) except for the Team events- Goju Ryu Kata only (except Open Division and WKF Division)- Novice divisions may repeat the same Kata- Intermediate and Advanced cannot repeat the same Kata in the consecutive rounds. (Can be alternated, e.g: A, B , A, B)
KUMITE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- All Kumite divisions are free sparring and stop time. Must wear proper protection gear.- First 8 points wins- Ages 11 and below: 1.5 minutes per bout / Ages 12-15: 2 minutes per bout / Ages 16 and up: 3 minutes per bout.- If there is a tie, the judges determine the winner based on form (Hantei). There is no Senshu.
TEAM KATA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Each Team can have 3-4 athletes. Three starting and one reserve.- Fee is per athlete basis. If the team wins, all athletes will receive medals.- Only 3 will perform at each bout. Can switch to other athletes in the next bout.- Goju Ryu Kata only. Novice divisions may repeat the same Kata. Intermediate and Advanced cannot repeat the same Kata in the consecutive rounds. (Can be alternated, e.g: A, B , A, B)

*We may be able to provide red/blue belts, gloves, shin guards, headgear, and body protection for athletes; however, availability cannot be guaranteed. Athletes are strongly advised to bring their own equipment. **Please note that kumite athletes will not be permitted to compete without proper protective gear, and ensuring the required equipment is the athlete's responsibility.**

AWARDS:

- Medals are presented to 1st, 2nd and two 3rd places.
- Participation medal will be presented to Athletes in the individual divisions, except 1st, 2nd and two 3rd places' recipients. No Participation medal for the Team events.
- Award ceremony will be held at the end of the Tournament (around 1:00pm) You are welcome to leave and come back for the Award ceremony. Athletes must be presented for the awards.

DIVISIONS AND SCHEDULE:

- The door will be opened between 8:00 AM to 8:15 AM
- Please try to bring an exact change for the Spectator Fee.
- Snack and water are allowed but please leave no trace.
- The Opening Ceremony will be sharp at 8:40 AM. All Athletes must attend. We suggest you arrive early.
- The tournament will start at around 9:00 AM. Athletes who didn't show up when marshalling will consider give up. No refund will be issued for any reason.
- All divisions and time are subject to change. Schedule time for each division could be +/- 30 minutes.
- Individual division may be combined based on the actual situation.
- Listen carefully to the announcement for the next marshaling division.
- Novice: 10 Kyu – 7 Kyu / Intermediate: 6 Kyu – 4 Kyu / Advanced: 3 Kyu – 1 Kyu
- Award Presentation and Group Photo is at around 1:00 PM. We hope to finish early, so we need everyone's cooperation.

I agree to abide by all rules, regulations, and decisions set forth by the tournament organizers, referees, judges, and officials. I fully understand and accept the risks associated with participation in karate tournaments, including, but not limited to, physical injury, emotional stress, and unforeseen accidents. Furthermore, I acknowledge that I have read, understood, and accepted the Terms of Conditions and Rules outlined in the following pages, which are incorporated into this agreement. I hereby waive any and all claims against Sekishinkan Karate, its directors, officers, instructors, coaches, judges, referees, volunteers, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns, as well as the facility owners and operators, arising out of my participation in this event. I affirm that I am in good health, physically fit, and have no conditions or ailments that would prevent me from safely participating in this tournament. I also understand that it is my responsibility to disclose any medical conditions or injuries to the tournament organizers before the event. For participants under the age of 19, I, as the parent or legal guardian of the participant, confirm that I have read and understood this agreement in full and agree to its terms on behalf of the minor. I further attest that I am legally authorized to sign this release and consent for the minor participant.

Terms of Condition and Rules (2026)

1. General Rules

- The tournament will follow the format of **Kata (forms)** and **Kumite (sparring)** competitions.
- All competitors should hold a valid and active Karate BC membership and demonstrate good sportsmanship, as well as respect towards referees, judges, and fellow athletes.
- Non-Karate BC members must have the approval of the Sekishinkan Chief Instructor before joining this tournament.

2. Categories

- Age Groups: Divisions will be based on age (4-7, 8-10-11-13, 14-16 and 17 above). Levels: Novice: 10 Kyu – 7 Kyu; Intermediate: 6 Kyu – 4 Kyu; Advanced: 3 Kyu to 1 Kyu

3. Attire and Equipment

- Competitors must wear clean **white Karate Dogi**. **Red and blue belts** represent two competitors
- Approved protective equipment is mandatory for Kumite:
 - Red and blue gloves, mouthguard, Shin/foot protectors, Head gear and body protectors.

4. Registration Procedure

- Complete the Athlete Agreement Form. All competitors, parents, and legal guardians must agree to and sign the Waiver of Liability.
- By registering, participants confirm acceptance of the terms and agree to this binding contract.
- Each registered athlete will be assigned an Athlete Number randomly. An Athlete Number Bib will be provided after registration and must be worn on the back of the Dogi during the tournament. Lost bibs will not be replaced, and athletes without them will not be allowed to compete. Athletes cannot request a specific number or change their assigned number. However, participants from the previous year's tournament may request the same number as last year at registration.
- Refunds will be provided if a doctor's note, indicating the athlete is unfit to compete, is submitted via email at least five (5) days before the tournament, or if the athlete's division is canceled. Refunds will be processed within 60 days after the tournament. No refunds, credits or transfers will be granted for any other reasons.

5. Kata Rules

- Competitors can only perform Goju-Ryu kata. Performing non-approved kata will be considered as disqualification.
- All divisions will use the Flag (Red/Blue) System. Single elimination with two athletes performs at the same time. Repechage may apply. Team Events may have variation of rules.
- Novice divisions may repeat the same kata. Intermediate and Advanced competitors cannot repeat the same kata in consecutive rounds (alternating patterns like A, B, A, B are allowed).
- Scoring standards will be based on technical performance (e.g., stances, timing, form) and athletic performance (e.g., power, rhythm, spirit).
- Elimination style: Winners progress based on judges' scores.

6. Kumite Rules

- Single elimination with two athletes performs at the same time. Repechage may apply. Team Events may have variation of rules
- All divisions are free sparring and stop time. Ages 10 and below: 1.5 minutes per bout, Ages 11-16: 2 minutes per bout, Ages 17 and up: 3 minutes per bout
- Scoring Points: Points are awarded as follows: 1 point (Yuko): Punch to the head, face, or body / 2 points (Waza-ari): Kick to the body / 3 points (Ippon): Kick to the head or successful sweep followed by a decisive technique.
- Prohibited Actions: Striking with excessive force / Attacks on forbidden areas (e.g., throat, groin) / Dangerous techniques without control
- Win Conditions: Highest score at the end of the match (First 8-point wins). If there is a tie, the judges determine the winner based on form (Hantei). There is no Senshu.

7. Penalties and Warnings

- Excessive contact, dangerous techniques, or attacks to prohibited areas.
- Avoiding engagement, stepping out of bounds, or unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Disqualification, or Hansoku (match forfeiture), could be executed without warning.

8. Awards

- Medals are presented to 1st, 2nd and two 3rd places. Participation awards will be presented to all others, except for the Team Events.
- Grand Championship Award (Kancho Cup)

9. Tournament Conduct and the Fair Participation

- We trust that an honest system benefits all participants. Therefore, competitors are expected to register only in the divisions appropriate to their age and skill level. If it is determined that an individual has registered in a division for the purpose of gaining an unfair advantage, the tournament administration reserves the right to withdraw any awards presented and to take further disciplinary action as deemed necessary. The tournament administration team and the WSK Sekishinkan Chief Instructor reserve all rights for decision-making regarding awards or medals.
- The decisions of referees and judges are final; no protests will be entertained.
- **Division Assignment:** Registered athletes will be assigned to divisions randomly. Athletes and parents must agree and accept that absolute fairness in arrangements cannot be guaranteed. The administration team assures there is no bias in the process, and complaints or contests will not be accepted.
- **Code of Conduct:** Disrespect or violation of rules may result in disqualification without refund.
- Safety is the top priority; all matches will be controlled to ensure the well-being of competitors.

10. Liability Release

- By participating, competitors and their guardians acknowledge that karate is a contact sport and involves risks of injury.
- **Release of Liability:** The tournament organizers, referees, judges, and volunteers will not be held responsible for any injuries, accidents, or damage incurred during the event.
- Participants agree to compete at their own risk and responsibility and must ensure they are physically and medically fit for competition.
- All participants (or their guardians, if under 19) must sign a liability waiver before competing.
- Registration confirms acceptance of these terms and agreements to the binding contract.

11. Privacy

- WSK Sekishinkan respects everyone's right to privacy.
- Information collected during registration (e.g., names, photos) will only be used for tournament-related purposes and karate promotions. It will not be shared with other organizations for commercial purposes.
